


## Enrolling Your Mac Laptop in Air Watch

All mobile devices need to be enrolled into Air Watch. Air Watch is a mobile device management (MDM) software and allows the school to push out updates to all devices. The CEO also requires that all devices connecting to its network be enrolled in Air Watch.


**To enrol your Mac laptop, please follow the steps below when you are connected to your home network.**

Your Mac laptop must be running Mac OS X 10.7 and above.


Launch your web browser, such as Chrome, FireFox or Internet Explorer and navigate to the following URL: <https://ds500.airwatchportals.com/devicemanagement/enrollment>






After clicking "Install", you will see the following screen.




The AirWatch Agent will download. Locate the dmg file in your Downloads folder and double click it to open it.




When you see the following screen, click the “Continue” button.




The Licence screen will appear. Click the “Continue” button.




Click the “Agree” button to continue the installation.




Click the “Install” button on the next screen.
